Rules must be followed

- **Any team found in violation of safety protocols teams will be removed from the league**
 - **Players/coaches not following the face covering mandate will have the match abandoned**
 - **Deliberate refusal**
 - **1 warning**
 - **Spectators not wearing face covering or social distancing, 1 parent per player, capacity limits**
 - **Face covering worn from car to car for all participants**

- **League Responsibilities:**
 - **Develop and update Operational Plan**
 - **Execute Communication Plan**
 - **Communicate directly with all stakeholders**
 - **Communicate and manage any issues related to Covid-19 immediately**
- **There are no fines or forfeits for Covid-19 related cancellations made in a timely manner**

Operational Plan

Highlights/Updates continued

- **Club Responsibilities**
 - **Field Map sent in pdf format for any facility that is a home field to OYSA**
 - **OYSA will set up webpage dedicated to field maps/instructions**
 - **Provide a monitor for every game that you are the home team**
 - **Listed in Affinity as the Home team even if you are away team**
 - **Communicate with the stakeholders in your club all protocols, guidelines, rules**
- **Covid-19 Monitor Responsibilities**
 - **Field/Complex Capacity Limits**
 - **No spectators inside the complex/field areas (Phase 1)**
 - **Spectators are physically distanced and wearing a face covering (Phase 2)**
 - **Report non-compliance to coaching staff to seek compliance, if compliance is not achieved game is abandoned and team will be removed from the league.**

Operational Plan Highlights/Updates continued

- **Referee Responsibilities**
 - **Masks required at all times**
 - **Removed from league if they don't**
 - **Verbally remind players/coaches to wear their face covering properly**
 - **Abandon match if player or coach is non-compliant**
 - **Does not include when a face covering drops down during the run of play**
 - **Team removed from league for non-compliance**
 - **Electronic whistle, whistle through mask, Pull mask up quickly then pull back down**
- **Coaching Staff Responsibilities**
 - **Mask required at all times**
 - **Have an extra face covering in case your face covering breaks**
 - **Covid-19 Check-In prior to match beginning**
 - **Ensure compliance of players and spectators with masks and social distancing**
 - **Leave field promptly after match ends**
 - **Use appropriate exit and waits until all players have been picked up**
 - **Provide 3 sanitized match balls per half**

Operational Plan

Highlights/Updates continued

- **Parent Responsibilities**
 - **Keep your child at home if you notice Covid-19 related symptoms**
 - **No spectators in Phase 1 counties**
 - **1 spectator per player in Phase 2 counties, face covering, and physical distancing required**
 - **Follow all field rules including drop-off details, entrances/exits, etc.**
 - **Drop off no earlier than 30 minutes prior to match starting**
 - **May differ field to field**
 - **Must remain in parking area if you remain onsite**
- **Player Responsibilities**
 - **Let coach know if you have any Covid-19 symptoms**
 - **Face covering must be worn at all times**
 - **Face covering may fall down during game play, pull up immediately**
 - **Have an extra face covering in case your face covering breaks**

Fields/Scheduling

- **8 grass fields**
 - **Centennial(Woodburn), Central Linn(Halsey), CFC(Salem), Cook Park(2)(Tigard), Crystal Lake(Corvallis), Legion(Woodburn), Morning Star(Bend)**
- **13 turf fields**
 - **CFC(Salem), Eastside(3)(Gresham), Hazelia(Lake Oswego), Hoodview(Happy Valley), Horizon(Tualatin), Husky(Sweet Home), Lincoln Park(Forest Grove), Mt View(2)Beaverton, Newberg HS, Snyder(Sherwood), THPRD(2)(Beaverton), Westside Christian (Tigard)**
- **Start scheduling Saturday at 12 pm**
 - **If a team needs to drop, we need to know by 9 am**
- **1st weekend 1 game only**
 - **Some teams will not have a game the first weekend**
 - **Following weekends we will do what we can to have 1 game a weekend**
 - **Fields and odd numbered brackets**

Game Day

- See Operational Plan for full details
- Teams/Spectators for Phase 2 sit on the same side of the field – diagram in Operational Plan
- Game Length:
 - U17 to U19/20 are 40-minute halves
- All games have a 5-minute halftime
- All games have a < 2-minute water break halfway through the half
- Check-In
 - A printed Official Match Roster is required at all games
 - Member Passes can be:
 - Digital member pass(Digital Player Pass in Affinity)
 - Use Game Day Hotline if referee does not allow you to use these
 - Physical laminated card
 - Recommend having both on hand just in case
- No throw-ins or slide tackling
