

PTTL Operations, Rules, and Game Day Expectations

PTTL Parents,

OYSA and the Portland Timbers & Thorns are so excited to have you back for the Fall PTTL!

With games beginning this weekend, it is critical that you read and understand the information referenced in this email.

PTTL Operations

Take time now to fully read and understand the [PTTL Operational Plan](#) found on the [OYSA Return to Play Information](#) page. This Operational Plan has a detailed list of the responsibilities that apply to YOU as a Parent (along with responsibilities for your child as a player).

Please understand that failure to adhere to these responsibilities may result in your team being removed from the league and an accompanying forfeiture of the league entry fee.

Key details for parents:

- Keep your child at home if they have any COVID-19 like symptoms.
- Check your child's temperature prior to the game – it must be below 100.4 F to participate. Report the temperature to your coach upon arrival.
- **No parents/guardians/spectators are allowed to be at the field in games in Phase 1 counties.** If you choose to remain on-site during the match, you must remain in the parking area of the field or park – preferably in your vehicle. This includes fields that only have street parking.
- **One parent or guardian per player is allowed to be at the field for games in Phase 2 counties.**
- **A parent or guardian attending a match, when allowed to attend (see above), is required to wear a face covering at all times when at the field.** Additionally, do not use your hands to return a ball to the field if it goes out of play.
- **Arrive to the match no earlier than 30 minutes prior to kickoff.**
- Reference the [field map](#) for your game to understand and follow all facility rules for drop-offs and entrances and exits.

Key details for players:

- **Face coverings are required at all times:** prior to, during, and after the match.
 - An easy way to remember: wear it from the time you exit your car all the way to the time you return to your car after the game.
 - They must be worn over the nose and mouth. Face shields are not allowed to be used, in the interest of player safety.
- If your face covering falls down during game play, pull it up as soon as possible.
- Bring an extra face covering in case your face covering breaks or becomes too wet.
- Bring both sets of jerseys to every game.
- Do not enter your field area until everyone from the previous game has left the field.
