Covid-19 Game Day Operation



At United PDX our top priority is returning to play in a safe manner with proper guidelines in place recommended by the CDC, Oregon Health Authority, USYSA, OYSA, & OSAA. We ask that our coaches, players, and parents understand and adhere to the guidelines put in place. These recommendations do not supersede or replace any applicable local, state, regional or federal health guidelines or requirements.

Guidelines are subject to change based on new information provided within the different phases of re-opening.

PARTICIPATION IS NOT MANDATORY. ONLY ATTEND ACTIVITIES WHEN COMFORTABLE.



Covid-19 General Hygiene Guidelines

- Avoid touching your face.
- Frequently wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Cover mouth and nose (with arm or elbow, not hands) when coughing or sneezing and wash hands afterward.
- Wear a face mask or covering and maintain 6ft social distancing.
- Frequently clean commonly used surfaces with an antiseptic cleanser.
- Avoid contact with other individuals.
- Maintain a distance of 6ft between you and others.
- Stay home if you feel sick and contact your health care provider.
- Notify United PDX and proper health authorities if a player or family member becomes ill or comes in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Covid-19 Game Day Protocol



Check In

- Enter & Exit Field through Designated Areas
- Prior arriving players need to do their COVID Pre Screening Survey and be cleared for games via email response.
- Opposing Players Must Follow OYSA COVID Pre Screening Requirements before entering the field.
- At arrival players need report to the team designated areas set by coaches/managers.
- If a team is on the field please wait in car until the game has finished and the field has been cleared for the next team to come on.

On Field

- Masks are required for coaches, players, referees, and managers.
- All may have periods when the mask can be pulled down to get fresh air once able to maintain 6ft social distancing requirements.

Field Monitor

- The Manager of the team playing will serve as the field monitor for the game. The role of the field monitor is to ensure there are no spectators at the field, traffic flow is happening properly, and cars are parked in proper designated areas.
- Manager from opposing team needs to be onsite to assist with managing opposing team.
- Field Monitors are allowed in seating area and must wear a mask

Video

- Both teams can have a designated video person to film games and/or provide live stream.

Exit

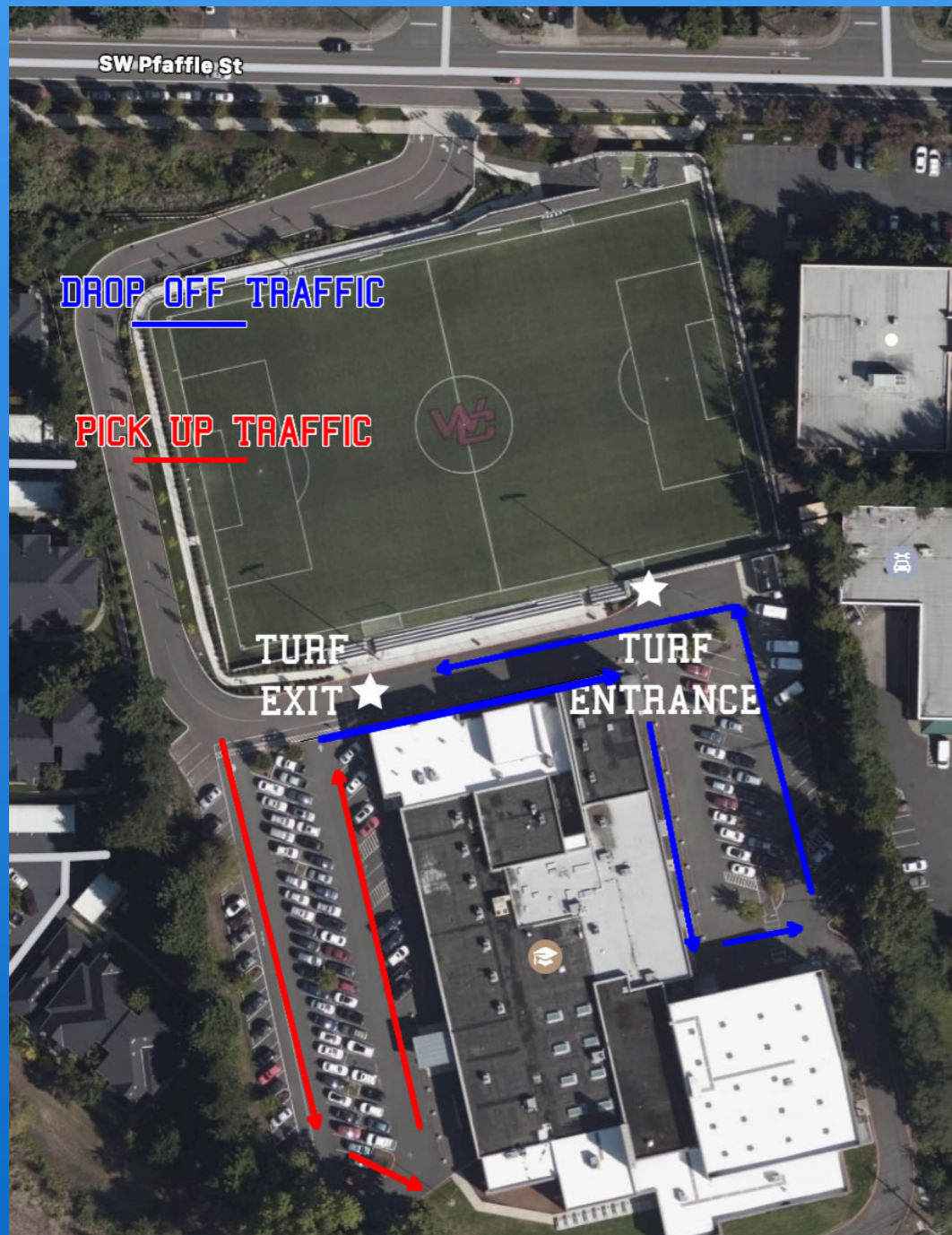
- Once game has ended players will exit through proper gate.
- No Gathering after the game

Covid-19 Field Use



- No group gatherings at any field location.
- Guides will be put in place for entrance & exit at each field.
- Please allow social distancing when entering or exiting the field.
- Sanitary Stations will be provided at each location for players to use before & after games.
- Staff will help guide players upon arrival & exit.
- Spectators: United PDX is in a Phase 1 County. Spectators, other than team officials, are not allowed on the field, the adjacent track, or on the field grounds. Parents can either drop their child off, or wait in their car. Clubs/teams from Phase 2 counties are expected to follow these Phase 1 requirements.
